REGISTRATION NUMBERS

In April 2008 there were **1632** registered occupational therapists in Western Australia.

Of these 7.5 per cent were males.

RENEWALS

In accordance with Regulation 8 of the Act - renewal payments will be due and payable by 30 June 2008.

Importantly, and in accordance with Section 35(1) of the Act there will be no flexibility with payments, and any practitioner non-financial as at 30 June 2008 will be removed from the Register.

Re-registration will then be necessary, requiring the practitioner to apply **IN PERSON** at the office of the Registration Board in South Perth, and provide the Board with the necessary documentation for re-registration.

Penalty payments may also be incurred.

HOW TO MAKE PAYMENT

Payments may be effected via cheque, money order or BPay (see note below).

Please **DO NOT** include cash if forwarding your payment through the post.
